## **Columbia Summer Core**

Combining Art Humanities and Music Humanities Core courses into a single experience offers the opportunity for a rich exchange between the multiple contexts of Western artistic and musical creation.



## **Eligibility**

- Must be a currently enrolled undergraduate student in Columbia College, Columbia Engineering, or the School of General Studies.
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and good academic and disciplinary standing.
- Although knowledge of German is not required, some study of the language will be useful in Berlin.

## **Housing**

You will be live in a residence hall that consists of double or triple rooms with a shared kitchen.

#### **Activities**

Guided trips to concerts, museums, and more to foster engagement outside the classroom.



#### Location

The program's home base and where you will take your classes is located at CIEE's Berlin Global Institute. At this state-of-the-art facility, you'll be conveniently near buses and the U-Bahn (metro).

### **Art Humanities & Music Humanities**

Art Humanities and Music Humanities in Berlin will make extensive use of the city through field trips to museums, live performances, and monuments. Theses courses will focus on the formal structure of works of architecture, painting, and other media, as well as use a "great works" approach that will look at the changing genres and styles of music from the Middle Ages to the present.
