Columbia Summer Core

Combining Art Humanities and Music Humanities Core courses into a single experience offers the opportunity for a rich exchange between the multiple contexts of Western artistic and musical creation.



Eligibility

- Must be a currently enrolled undergraduate student in Columbia College, Columbia Engineering, or the School of General Studies.
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and good academic and disciplinary standing.
- Although knowledge of French is not required, some study of the language will be useful in Paris.

Housing

You will be housed in double rooms at a residence in Paris. It is required to live in the program housing.



Location

The program's home base and where you will take your classes is located at the historic Reid Hall. For over a century, Reid Hall has a long history of intellectual and cultural exchange.

Activities

Guided field trips to the Louvre, Versailles, and more foster engagement outside the classroom.

Art Humanities and Music Humanities in Paris will make extensive use of the city through field trips to museums, live performances, and monuments. These courses will focus on the formal structure of works of architecture, painting, and other media, as well as use a "great works" approach that will look at the changing genres and styles of music from the Middle Ages to the present.
