The CASA-Cuba program will challenge you to achieve a critical understanding of the key issues facing Cuba today and enable you to interact with some of the country's leading academic experts in the social sciences, arts, and the humanities.



Eligibility

- Must be a currently enrolled undergraduate student in good academic and disciplinary standing
- · Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
- Minimum 3.0 average language GPA
- In order to participate, students need to complete a minimum of one Spanish content course above SPAN UN3300, or the equivalent, prior to departure

Housing

CASA-Cuba offers homestays with local families that are in walking distance to the CASA Center.

Activities

Guided field trips and weekly seminars offer deeper engagement outside the classroom.



Academics

Students will have an opportunity to enroll in up to four (4) courses, choosing between courses offered at CASA and up to two (2) courses on the main campus of the University of Havana.
