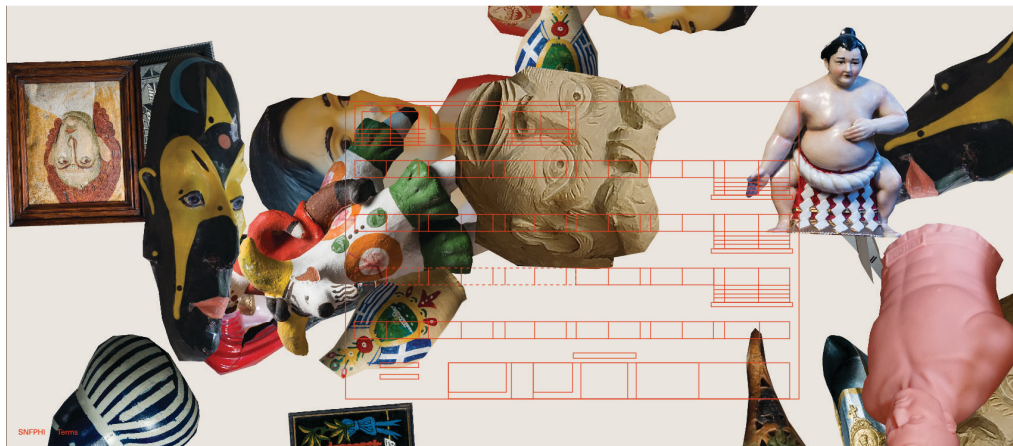


Columbia Summer Global Core in Athens:

# CURATORIAL PROJECT



Examine how cultural and urban spaces shape understandings of Greek identity, nationalism, and the *polis* (city) across time through seminars, site visits, and collaborative projects. Columbia's Stavros Niarchos Foundation Public Humanities Initiative funds ongoing projects spearheaded by local artists, curators, educators, community leaders, and oral historians. Students will meet these innovators and be introduced to their work which will enhance their studies in novel ways.

The program culminates in an online permanent exhibition curated by the students that is historically based and contributes to the public discourse about contemporary Greece and its place in the world.
