Students join an interdisciplinary and international research team to conduct behavioral science research. The program provides students with the tools and skills needed to complete each part of the collaborative project which culminates in students writing a final manuscript that is submitted for publication for which all students receive co-authorship.

At the end of the program, students will also present their findings during the Junior Researcher Programme Conference.
