

The 2022 Finley Fellowship for Venetian Studies

Through the generosity of Carol and John Finley, the Department of Art History and Archaeology is once again awarding a fellowship for undergraduate students participating in Columbia University's Summer Program in Venice. The *Finley Fellowship for Venetian Studies* consists of a stipend of \$2,000 to help defray the costs for airfare and out-of-pocket expenses associated with the 2022 Summer Program in Venice. Recipients of the fellowship will be known as *Finley Fellows*.

Eligibility:

All students who have been accepted as participants in the Venice Summer program and have chosen at least one art history course as part of their Venice summer curriculum are eligible to apply for the *Finley Fellowship for Venetian Studies*. Preference will be given to students who have declared a major in Art History, History and Theory of Architecture, or Art History and Visual Arts at the Department of Art History and Archaeology or art history majors at Barnard College.

Application Procedure:

Eligible students are asked to submit their *Finley Fellowship* application consisting of:

- (1) A short cover letter indicating past art history/architectural history/visual arts courses taken and course choices for the Venice Summer Program
- (2) A CV with an indication of current GPA and past prizes and fellowships received at Columbia University
- (3) An informal letter of acceptance into the Venice Summer Program from the Fay Ju in the Office of Undergraduate Global Experience
