KCJS Scholarship Application

Scholarship Information:

The Kyoto Consortium for Japanese Studies (KCJS) offers a limited number of scholarships for participation in the KCJS program. The number and amount of awards vary depending on the pool of applicants. Typically, the awards range from \$500-\$5,000 per semester.

All students are encouraged to apply to additional scholarship programs such as the Bridging Scholarships for Study Abroad in Japan, Gilman Scholarship (for Pell grant recipients), the Freeman Asia Scholarship and the Boren Scholarship. Please check the section under Financial Aid Considerations on the KCJS webpage for links and more information.

Eligibility:

- Students must be admitted to the KCJS program and demonstrate financial need. Students who do not receive financial aid but can demonstrate financial need are welcome to apply. International students are welcome to apply.
- Applications must be submitted with the required materials. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

• For spring: October 1

 peak travel times.
- Meals, Visa Fees & Local Transportation: Please see the budget sheet for your program on the OGP website for these estimated costs.
- Health Costs: Will you need to purchase health insurance to cover you during your time abroad?
 Accident insurance? Immunizations? Prescription drug refills? Research and include any additional medical costs associated with traveling to your proposed destination.
