Eligibility

- Must be a currently enrolled undergraduate student in good academic and disciplinary standing at Columbia University or Barnard College
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
- Students do not need to major in English and Comparative Literature,but they should demonstrate motivation to study the topic of the global seminar

Academics

In addition to the Columbia Global Seminar, you enroll in two or three QMUL courses.
