Eligibility

- Must be a currently enrolled undergraduate, graduate, or post-graduate student in good academic and disciplinary standing
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
- Minimum 3.0 average language GPA for courses taught in Italian
- Students must meet prerequisites for individual courses

You will live in furnished, shared apartments located throughout the main island of Venice.

Guided field trips and events are designed to introduce you to the local culture.

You have the opportunity to choose your courses according to personal aspirations and interests. Previous subjects offered include Italian language, culture, film and art history.
